Skill level: Intermediate to Advanced

Materials List

Fabrics are from the Software line designed by Yolanda Fundora for Windham Fabrics. Kits are available for \$19.95, including postage (if ordered with the quilt kit) to the Continental US.

Fat quarter yellow blossoms	3/8 yd. yellow dots
Fat quarter blue blossoms	5/8 yd. blue trees
12" square fusible web	
One 20" pillow form	Pair of small, sharp scissors

Cutting Instructions

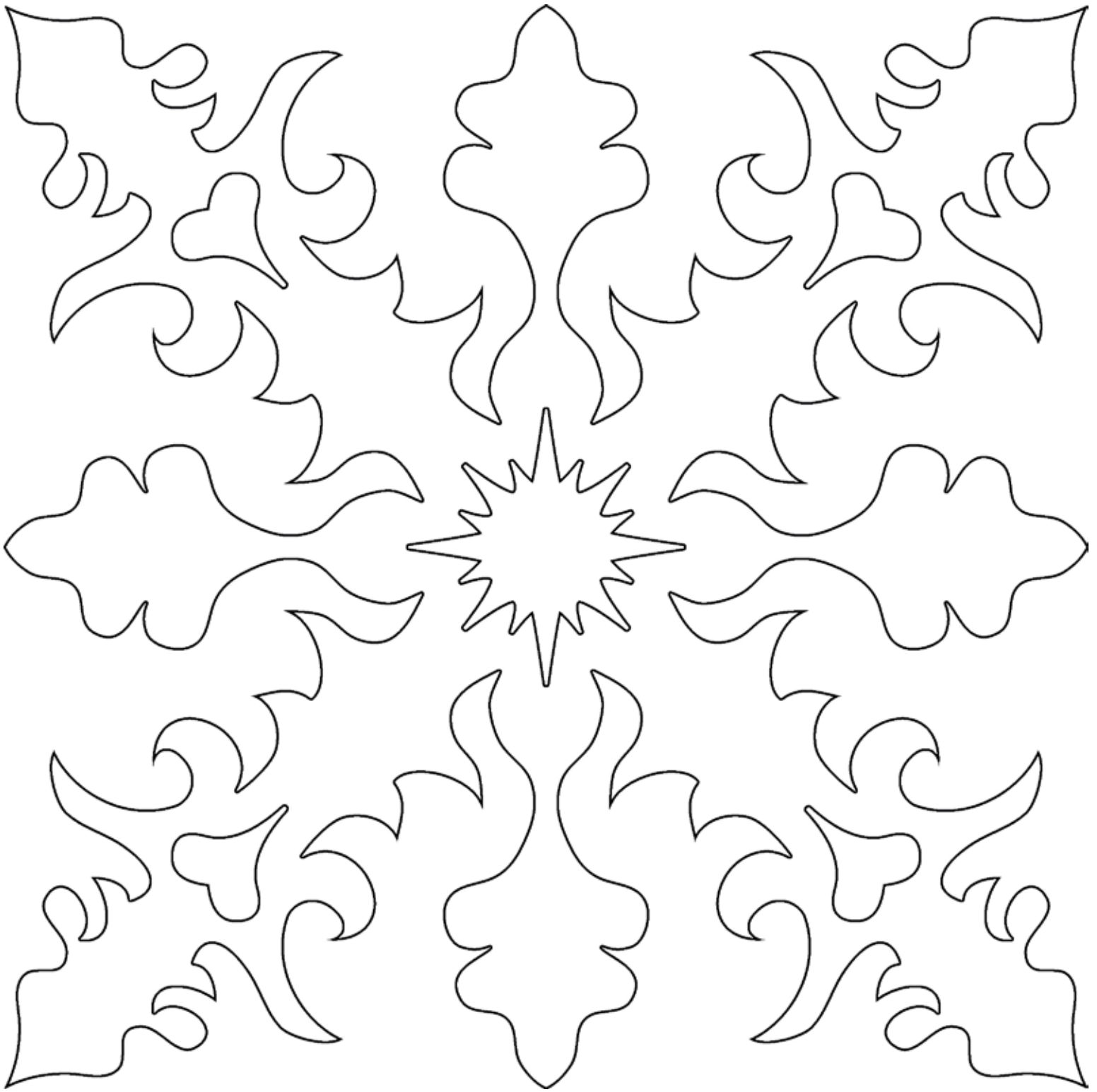
- yellow dot print - one 12 1/2" square
- blue trees print - two 20 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles for pillow backing; two 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" pieces for border; two 2 1/2" x 20 1/2" pieces for border
- yellow blossoms, yellow dots, blue blossoms and blue dots - four 1" x 12 1/2" strips from each print
- yellow blossoms - four 2 1/2" squares

Fusing Instructions:

1. Trace the pattern sheet for the design onto the paper side of 12" square of fusible web.
2. Fuse the motif to the wrong side of the blue blossom 12 1/2" square.
3. Cut out the motif carefully on the drawn line. This work is made easier by using small, pointy, sharp scissors. Take your time and cut accurately.
4. Remove the paper and center the motif on the yellow dot square and fuse in place, following manufacturer's instructions
5. At this point, you can zigzag or buttonhole stitch around the outside edges, if desired. For the quilt pictured, we assembled the entire quilt and then did raw edge applique by stitching free-motion around the edge of all motifs after the quilt sandwich was basted together. This secured the motifs during the quilting step.

Sewing Instructions:

1. Make strip sets by sewing together the blue and yellow 1" x 12 1/2".
2. Sew two border strips to either side of the yellow background square. Attach a 2 1/2" yellow grass square to either side of the remaining two strips and sew to the top and bottom of the block to complete.
3. Fold in one 12 1/2" edge on each of the pillow backing pieces 1/4" and then again 1/4". Stitch to finish the edges.
4. With right sides together, sew the pillow back pieces to the pillow front, overlapping the backing pieces in the center.
5. Turn right side out and insert the pillow form.
