

REVERSIBLE NAPKINS – TWO VERSIONS



Reversible Napkins (makes 4)

Materials List:

- 1 yard focus fabric for napkin front
- 1 yard contrasting fabric for napkin back

Instructions:

1. Cut four 18” squares from each fabric.
2. Place one focus fabric square right sides together with one contrasting fabric.
3. Sew around all edges, using a $\frac{1}{4}$ ” seam allowance. Leave a 3” opening in the center of one side for turning.
4. Turn right side out, press, tucking in the seam allowance on the opening. Edge stitch around all four edges. This will close the opening and secure the edges of the napkin.
5. Repeat to make three more.



Bordered Reversible Napkins (makes 4)



Materials List:

1 yard focus fabric for napkin front – cut into four 14” squares

1 yard contrasting fabric – cut into four 18” squares

2/3 yard border fabric for napkin back – cut eight 18” x 2 1/4” strips and eight 14” x 2 1/4” strips

Instructions:

1. Sew a 14” border strip onto two opposite sides of the four focus fabric 14” squares. Press
2. Sew a 18 1/2” border strip onto the remaining sides and press.
3. With right sides together, sew each one of these napkin fronts to a contrasting 18 1/2” square, leaving a 3” opening in the center of one side.
4. Turn to the right side and press. Edge stitch around all edges, including the opening. This will close the opening and secure the edges of the napkin.



You can have lots of fun playing with folding these bordered napkins to make custom table settings. Great for mixing & matching fat quarters.
